

STUDENT PHOTOGRAPHS AT UNIVERSITY EVENTS

Photographs are commonly taken at University events by MBKU Multimedia Services and other personnel. These photographs may be used in University publications/communications including use on the University website and on the University's social media platforms.

Please note: You do not have to be photographed. If you do not want your photograph used, the best way to ensure this is by not posing for photographs taken by University officials. Photographs containing groups of students and do not list the names of students are considered directory information and may be used without additional consent (see "Directory Information (<https://catalog.ketchum.edu/university-catalog/university-policies-procedures/student-records-policies-procedures/#directoryinfo>)" policy). Photographs and video obtained at public events may also be used at the University's discretion. If a photograph is used that lists student names, a University designee will review the FERPA Confidentiality block list. All students who have previously indicated a Category II FERPA block will not be used.
